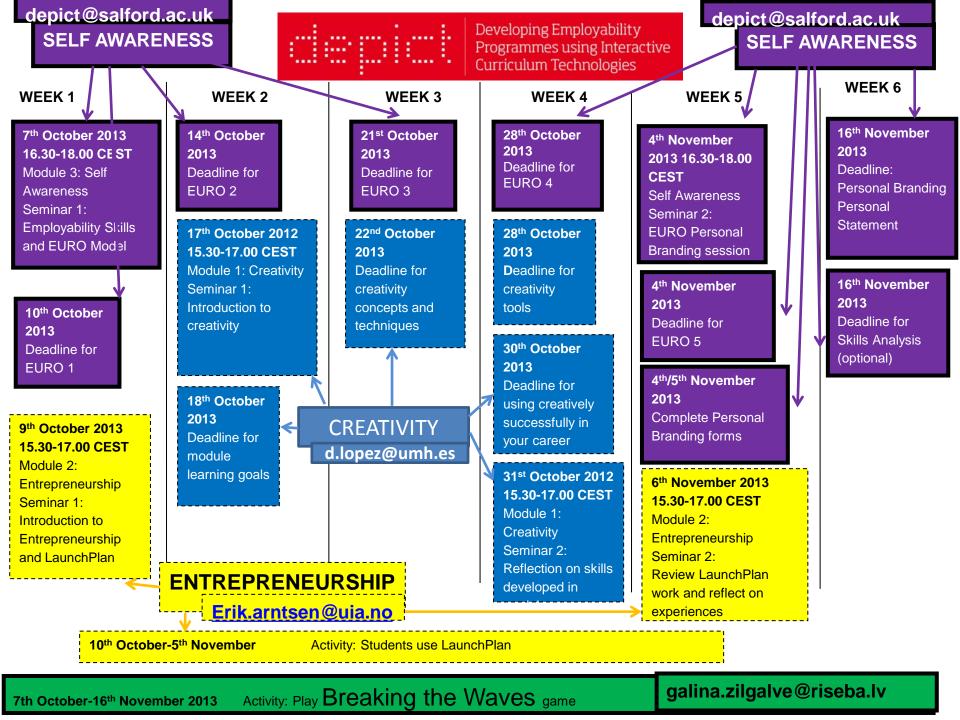

What am I being asked to do?

You are being asked to take part in a discussion, which will last about an hour. During the group you will be asked to talk about your experiences working with the project. With your permission, the discussion will be audio recorded. There are no right or wrong answers – we are only interested in what you think.

Will anybody find out what I have said?

No, nobody will be able to find out what you have said. We are holding several discussion groups. The things that people talk about during this discussion will be summarized and included in a report for the Universities taking part and the funders by a company called Brainbox Research, but nobody will find out who said what.

Do I have to take part?

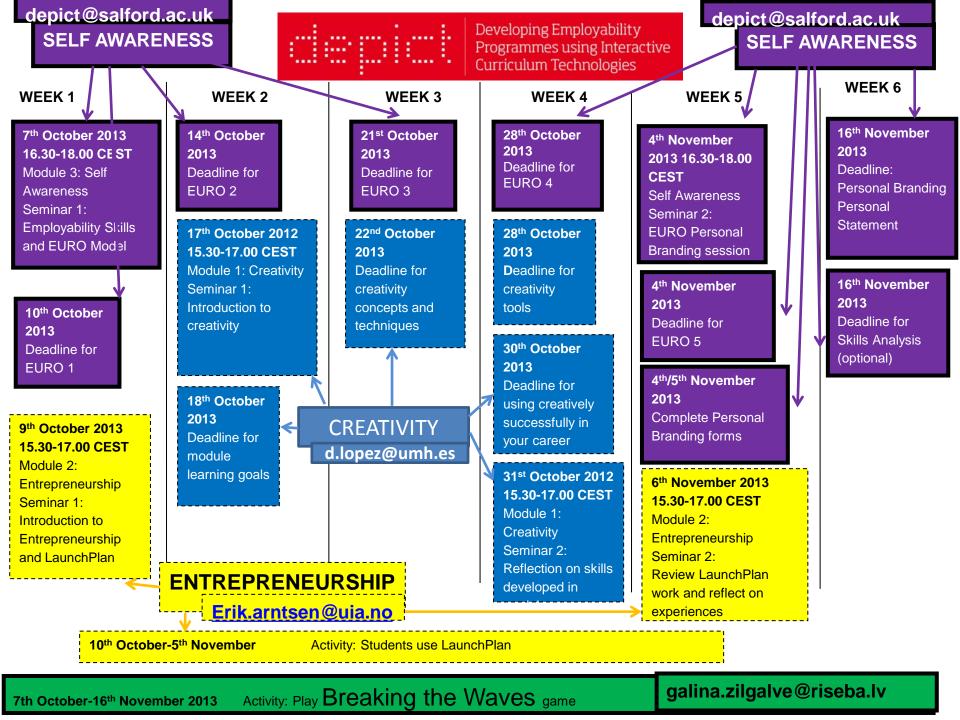
